

How to start studying at the Preparatory department?

1 Submit the application

Prepare the documents in electronic format, upload them on the website

List of required documents:

- Passport (validity period at least 2 years)
- Notarized translation of the passport into Russian
- Filled application form (posted on the website)
- A bank statement in student's name with an account balance of \$4,500 or the equivalent in local currency
- Student's photo (white background, high resolution)



2 Receive the confirmation

After submitting the documents via the website wait for the confirmation from a specialist of the university within 7 business days.



3 Obtain the e-visa invitation

Within the period of 80 days, you can expect an email containing the e-visa invitation to be sent to the email address you provided while submitting the documents via the website.



4 Receive the visa

After receiving the e-visa invitation, apply for a visa at the Russian Consulate in your country. Be advised that it is essential for you to arrive in Russia within the first 45 days from the date indicated in your e-visa invitation.



5 Arrival in Russia

Before arriving in Russia, be sure to click on the tab on the website «before arrival» and carefully read the information provided there.
